Kansas Humanities Council Seeks Board Members

TOPEKA - The Kansas Humanities Council is currently seeking nominations of Kansans for service on its 22-member Board of Directors. Nominations are due by March 31, 2010.

According to Shannon McPartland, chair of the Membership committee, "Anyone who has interest in the humanities in Kansas should consider serving on the board or nominating an individual who would give and gain from service on this board."

The KHC Board of Directors is a volunteer board. Members have financial oversight of the organization, take an active and participatory role in fundraising, set policy, and promote awareness of the council. Board members serve for a three-year term, with the possibility of renewal for a second three-year term. Meetings of the full board are held three times a year in locations across the state.

The Kansas Humanities Council is a non-profit organization that supports community-based cultural programs, serves as a financial resource through an active grant-making program, and encourages Kansans to participate in their communities.
